**PURPOSE OF WORKSHOP:** To begin preliminary discussions with Emergency Management Contacts (EMC's), flood managers/stormwater managers and other county/Community contacts: in the areas identified/surrounding County's by the Texas Department of Emergency Management (TDEM) and the General Land Office/Coastal Program (GLO). We will also review data/resources and tools available to Texas counties and communities impacted by Hurricane Harvey in flood management planning. The workshop will request representatives from the following federal agencies; FEMA, USACE, NOAA, USGS and EPA; representatives from State agencies; TDEM, GLO, Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Texas Commission for Environmental Quality (TCEQ), Texas A& M Agri-life, and others.

**PROCESS:** To gather information from each partner regarding roles and responsibilities and to identify linkages to supporting the development of the baseline outline for a Regional Flood Management Plan. The process will include sharing information, identifying information gaps and determine what water resources-related projects and activities are in process to support the development of a Draft Plan. An informational Roadmap, developed for each Regional area, will allow EMC's and others to begin to prepare a draft Regional Flood Management Plan.

**NEXT STEPS:** This workshop is expected to identify areas and issues that will be further addressed in separate meetings with additional entities and community representatives. A listing of activities and a meeting report will be provided to participants following the workshop. These follow up materials will enable area representatives to continue discussions and develop the pieces needed for a draft Regional Flood Management Plan, and to identify areas of concern and options for supporting any future water resource management.

State and Federal Partners will support these workshops through staff participation and, as identified, available Technical Assistance resources. Workshop is FREE.

County EMC's, Rebuild Teams, Flood Plain Managers/Stormwater managers are encouraged to determine/identify/prioritize what is needed to support the development of a Roadmap for a Regional Flood Management Plan specific to their area identified.
